BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JUNE 9, 2020, at 5 p.m.

The votes for the Board of Education members, School Budget and Library Board of Trustees is being conducted by ABSENTEE BALLOT. Ballots were mailed out to all registered voters in New Rochelle on Thursday, May 28th.

MAKE SURE YOUR VOTE COUNTS!!!

1. The letter you will receive contains a stamped and self-addressed envelope.
2. **You must PUT THE BALLOT INTO BOTH ENVELOPES.**
3. **You must sign, date and seal the first envelope. This is the "OATH envelope."**
4. **Then insert the OATH envelope into the return envelope addressed to the district.**
5. **Mail or drop off your ballot (see below)**

MAIL your ballot by Wednesday, June 3rd to ensure that it is received on time.

OR

DROP OFF YOUR BALLOT AT CITY HALL

Monday - Friday, June 1 through June 5, from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.;
Monday, June 8, from 8:00 AM - 4:30 p.m.; and
Tuesday, June 9, from 8:00 AM - 5:00 p.m.

Approach the City Hall entrance from the parking lot off Beaufort Place. Tell the guard you are there to vote. The guard will alert Mr. Ron Fortune, a District employee, election Board of Registration Member and Certified Election Inspector. Mr. Fortune will bring the lockbox cart to you. Insert your envelope(s) into the slot in the lockbox.
